

Drill Lesson Plan

Live scenario of a multi-vehicle accident.
(Involving rescue of entrapped patients)

Objective

To give an overall “hands on” experience in the event of a MVA. Command functions as well as sector responsibilities will be practiced. “Task” level responsibilities will be in forms of first responders, fire fighters, Gold Cross, and extrication teams.

Safety Considerations

Common knowledge of who the lead instructor is.
Professionalism
Practice safety with all equipment
Gloved hands when handling tools
Observe all traffic laws
Overall Safety Officer Appointed (no question who S.O. is and what functions are)

Equipment

Firefighter PPE
Lighting when needed
Apparatus (E40; R41; P41; S40; S41)

Lesson

- 1.) **Emergency Response**
 - a. Personnel will be staged according to responding order.
 - b. Units will respond in as if this was a live call (with due regard to safety)
 - c. Units will stage their vehicles with thoughts of the needs on the scene.
 - d. Proper communication to “dispatch” on additional needs.
 - e. Overall Command assumed by first due fire apparatus.

- 2.) **Scene Size Up**
 - a. First arriving fire apparatus conduct detailed, short size-up with regard to incoming units.
 - b. Update scene size up after initial contact with EMS and initial investigation.

- 3.) **Scene Management**
 - a. Designate extrication team (ext. officer, tools, power unit, hose line).
 - b. Assess scene priorities.
 - c. Direct incoming crews.

- 4.) **Extrication Priorities**
 - a. Triage information from EMS authority.

- 5.) **Safety Priorities**
 - a. Hot zone designation.
 - b. Control of crews operating.
 - c. Control of EMS Authority
 - d. Extrication team/s protection in place. (Hose line)
 - e. Lighting.
 - f. Staging
 - g. *Designation of “Safety Officer” observed!*

- 6.) **Critique Session**
 - a. Overall comments.
 - b. What went well?
 - c. What can be improved?

- 7.) **Hands on session for additional members.**
 - a. All members not involved in the initial scenario. (Tool Time)
